Thank you for continuing to consult with the New York State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO). We have reviewed the submitted materials in accordance with the New York State Historic Preservation Act of 1980 (section 14.09 of the New York Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation Law). These comments are those of the Division for Historic Preservation and relate only to Historic/Cultural resources.

We have reviewed your recent submission dated July 1, 2021 for this project. This submission includes a proposed site plan indicating vegetative buffers surrounding the solar arrays as previously requested by our office. We note that our previous letter indicated that the PV facility would occupy 8.13 acres of the 90-acre site while the actual figure is roughly 31 acres of the site.

Based on this review, and the additional information provided, it is the opinion of the SHPO that the proposed project will have No Adverse Impact to historic and cultural resources.
