1. Call to Order

Supervisor LaGrange called the hearing to order at 7:55 PM regarding proposed Heldervale Water District Extension #11. This again was published in the Altamont Enterprise. It takes care of an extension off Route 85 for the Olsen project which consists of storage units behind Stewart's. Attorney Naughton noted that there is a vacant lot in the front too that is shown as a blank slate right now. Supervisor LaGrange said that there is water to that lot, but it's not in the Heldervale District. Bethlehem allows us 150 feet. This will form a district extension to Heldervale and encompass the entire property.

Mrs. Elliott was in favor of this extension. She thinks it's a good plan. She was in favor of the first one also; however, on our document there are two different numbers. In the beginning of the document it says \$8,500 is the cost for Mr. Olsen, but as you go through the rest of the document its \$8,000. It should be consistent. Supervisor LaGrange thought it was a typo. Mrs. Elliott thought \$8,000 was the number. Attorney Naughton will look at the map, plan, and report for whatever the engineer said the estimated cost is. Supervisor LaGrange said that it will be corrected.

Councilperson Snyder made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilperson Hennessy. The hearing adjourned at 7:58 PM.
