Local Law 4 of the Year 2013

New Scotland Ethics Law

WHEREAS, the Town of New Scotland adopted an Ethics Law (last revised by Local Law 1 of the Year 2013) pursuant to Article 18 of the General Municipal Law; and

WHEREAS, the Ethics Law sets forth the standards of conduct for the guidance of the officers and employees of the municipality with respect to disclosure of interests in legislation before the local governing body, holding of investments in conflict with official duties, private employment in conflict with official duties, future employment, and such other standards as may be deemed advisable; and

WHEREAS, Section 22 of the Ethics Law requires the Town officers and employees listed on Exhibit A of the Ethics Law to file a signed annual disclosure statement; and

WHEREAS, the Ethics Law authorizes the Town Board to amend, from time to time, the list of officers and employees subject to the annual disclosure requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board established the position of Commissioner of Public Works, and thereafter made an appointment to fill the position of the Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to amend Exhibit A, which is annexed to the Ethics Law, to include the position of Commissioner of Public Works to the list of officers and employees subject to the annual disclosure requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Town Board of the Town of New Scotland hereby amends the Town of New Scotland Ethics Law as follows:

1. Substantive Provision. The list of officers and employees set forth on Exhibit A annexed to the Ethics Law is hereby amended to include the position of Commissioner of Public Works, and the Exhibit A referenced in Section 22 of the Ethics Law shall be replaced with the "Exhibit A" annexed hereto.
2. Rescission. The Exhibit A annexed to Local Law 1 of the Year 2012 of the Town of New Scotland is hereby rescinded and superseded.
3. Effective Date. This Local Law shall be effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)



I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. ___ of 20 ___ of the County of _____ State of New York, having been submitted to the electors at the General Election of November _____ 20 ___, pursuant to subdivisions 5 and 7 of section 33 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the cities of said county as a unit and a majority of the qualified electors of the towns of said county considered as a unit voting at said general election, became operative.

(If any other authorized form of final adoption has been followed, please provide an appropriate certification.)

I further certify that I have compared the preceding local law with the original on file in this office and that the same is a correct transcript therefrom and of the whole of such original local law, and was finally adopted in the manner indicated in paragraph 1, above.


