Local Law 7 of the Year 2010

**A local law staying the application of certain sections
of the New Scotland Ethics Law.**

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of New Scotland as follows:

Section 1. Purpose.

On June 9, 2010 the New Scotland Town Board adopted the New Scotland Ethics Law (Local Law 4 of the Year 2010), which became effective August 1, 2010. The Ethics Law provides several new standards of conduct and disclosure requirements for officers and employees of the Town of New Scotland and also creates an Ethics Board. Among other things, the Ethics Law provides a procedure for officers and employees to request advisory opinions from the Ethics Board concerning application of the Ethics Law to specific situations. Certain officers and employees have requested that the Town Board defer application of the substantive provisions of the Ethics Law for a period of time to allow them the opportunity to request advisory opinions from the Ethics Board in advance of the substantive provisions taking effect. The purpose of this local law is to defer the effective date of the substantive provisions of the Ethics Law to January 1, 2011 so as to allow time for the Ethics Board to respond to requests for advisory opinions.

Section 2. Effective Date of Ethics Law.

Sections 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 38 and 41 of the New Scotland Ethics Law (Local Law 4 of the Year 2010), which became effective August 1, 2010, shall remain effective. All other provisions of that law shall be effective as of January 1, 2011.
