A local law Authorizing Certain Notices to be Mailed with Tax Bills.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of New Scotland as follows:
(Name of Legislative Body)

Section 1. The purpose of this law is to permit certain notices to be enclosed with tax bills.

Section 2. The tax collector, or other appropriate officer or employee of the Town of New Scotland, is hereby authorized to enclose with any property, special district, or other tax bill issued by the Town of New Scotland notices that have been approved by unanimous vote of the New Scotland Town Board.

Section 3. The Town Board may, by unanimous vote, approve the mailing of certain notices with tax bills. Only notices containing matters of public importance shall be so approved and shall not include any advertisements or items of a political nature.

Section 4. This local law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.


