A local law to permit Eligible Funds Veterans' Exemption on a Pro rata basis

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of New Scotland has reviewed and passed the following resolution at a Regular Town Board Meeting of September 12, 1994, to schedule a Public Hearing for the continuation of the Eligible Funds Veterans' Exemption on a Pro Rata Basis; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearing was duly held at the Town Hall, Town of New Scotland, on September 28, 1994, at 6:30 P.M.; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of New Scotland has heard from the interested people who have spoke favorably for the passage of said exemption, and the Town feels that it is in the best interest of the Town of New Scotland to adopt such law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that it is ordered by the Town Board of the Town of New Scotland that it adopt Local Law No. 3 of 1994, a Local Law to permit eligible fund veterans' exemption on a pro rata basis and that it be enacted by the Town Board of the Town of New Scotland, as follows:

SECTION 1: The citizens of the Town of New Scotland who qualify for veterans' exemption may take an option for eligible funds veterans' exemption or alternative veterans' exemption, as they deem appropriate.

SECTION 2: The Town of New Scotland Assessor is hereby authorized and directed to pro rate the Eligible Funds Veterans' Exemption that are presently in effect, by either increasing or decreasing such exemption by the change in the level of the assessment for the Town of New Scotland.

SECTION 3: The Town of New Scotland Town Assessor is authorized to apply this Eligible Funds Veterans' Exemption retroactively pursuant to the provisions of Section 458 of the Real Property Tax Law, Section 4.

SECTION 4: That nothing in the local law shall authorize or allow any veteran to make any claim for refund for any prior year tax paid or create a claim against any governmental unit, including the Town of New Scotland, as a result of this local law.

SECTION 5: Any Veterans' Exemption that was changed from Eligible Funds to Alternative Veterans' Exemption due to the re-valuation of the Town of New Scotland may be changed back to the Eligible Funds Exemption if requested by the eligible veteran.
