Local Law No. 8 of the year 2006

A local law Authorizing the Help America Vote Act portion of the town tax bill to be itemized as a separate line item.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of New Scotland as follows:

Section 1. The purpose of this law is to permit charges related to the Help America Vote Act (HAVA) to be listed as a separate line item of the total amount of tax levied on each parcel on the town tax bill.

Section 2. The Tax Collector, and any other appropriate officer or employee of the Town of New Scotland, are hereby authorized and directed to itemize all costs associated with HAVA as a separate line item on Town of New Scotland tax bills.

Section 3. This local law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
